A New Way to Give in Support of St. Paul Lutheran Church



The council is pleased to announce an additional way for you to give in support of the ministries of St. Paul. In addition to giving by check, electronic funds transfer from your bank or electronic giving through Vanco, you can now give using a mobile app called GivePlus+. This is also a Vanco giving option.

GivePlus+ is a free app that you will need to download from Apple's App Store or Google's Play Store. You can search for the app using the words "GivePlus Church." There are no fees associated with using the app.

After you've downloaded the app, you'll need to search for the church. St. Paul is identified as "Saint Paul Lutheran Churc." Then you can set-up your account. Once you've linked your account to the church, you'll not need to do this step again.

On the app, you can set-up a one-time gift or recurring donations in a frequency that works best for you. Your donation can be made immediately or scheduled for a later date.

You'll have the option to connect your checking or saving account to the app or give by credit card. Once you've established these giving preferences, they will be ready for you the next time you log into the app. You can change your password, frequency, and giving method at any time.

Please note that if you're giving by credit card, you'll have the option to add 1.5% to your offering to offset processing fees.

A Message from the Council President

December 12, 2020

Dear Members of Saint Paul:

I am writing on behalf of the Congregation Council to provide updated information regarding the election process for new council members and the approval of a budget for the 2021 fiscal year. Pursuant to our constitution, the election of new Congregation Council members normally occurs during the month of October. Subsequently, a new budget is presented and adopted by the congregation during the month of December. Unfortunately, the pandemic has resulted in our inability to meet face-to-face and worship together since March. As a result, we have been unable to fulfill our constitutional requirements as we plan and look ahead to 2021. Consequently, at its November meeting the Congregation Council took action to keep the church operating until such time our constitutional obligations can be fulfilled. Please note the following:

- -The current Congregation Council members and officers will remain in place until new elections can be held during October 2021. At that time, the election cycle will move forward as normal following a one-year moratorium on voting.
- -The budget as adopted by the congregation for the 2020 fiscal year will remain in effect for 2021. Basically, the Congregation Council has adopted a "Continuing Resolution", until such time that the congregation can meet in a duly announced and called session for the purpose of approving a new budget.

I along with the members of the Congregation Council appreciate your continued support and prayers as we work with Pastor Northrup to carry out our mission at Saint Paul. We are indeed fortunate that Pastor Northrup agreed to serve as our minister and as the result of her leadership our congregation has developed a robust social media and web-based presence, she offers limited services for communion, we continue to feed the hungry because of committed volunteers and Pastor is diligently working to make recommendations as we prepare for our return to worship in the sanctuary. Finally, make plans now to attend our virtual Christmas Eve service at 7 pm via Facebook Live. While we were forced to cancel plans for our outdoor service, we can still worship together and share many of our Christmas traditions via Facebook. As a church family, we always look forward to our Christmas Eve service each year. Make plans now to attend!

- Disposable masks are available on the table when you enter.
- Space yourselves out in the sanctuary if possible, leave a row between you and the person in front of you.
- When you depart, wear your mask until you are away from others.
